Board approved the recommendations made by the BWC with following observations:

- i. Progress of Phase II construction, being monitored by the CPWD is extremely slow. The deadline for completion has already been revised a couple of times. CPWD is unlikely to even meet the revised deadline, if the slow pace continues. The matter may be pursued regularly with higher authorities of the CPWD CPWD should invoke the penalty clause in case the delay is attributable to NCC, the construction agency.
- ii. Construction of school building should be taken up in a phased manner with a well-planned design having scope of future expendability as per need.

From time to time, the institute acquires assets to meet its objective. Over a period of time, these equipment get worn out beyond economical repair or become obsolete. Since such assets unnecessarily occupy valuable space, a need was felt to formulate a policy for disposal of obsolete items. The policy so formulated was presented in the meeting of Associate Deans and was improved based on suggestions received there. The final version of the policy was placed before the Board.

Board approved the policy related to disposal of different types of scraps. While approving the policy, the Board desired to get the records of various assets digitized for keeping secure the information, required for disposal of obsolete items.

With the view to regulate the procedure of forwarding the applications of employees for outside employment including the ceiling on number of applications to be forwarded in a calendar year, a committee comprising Registrar, A.Dean (Admin.) and A.Dean (Faculty Affairs) was constituted to formulate the guidelines. After perusing the recommendations, the Board suggested to obtain an undertaking from a faculty member joining the Institute that he/she will not leave the institute for 02 years from the date of arrival of equipment indented by him/her costing Rs. 20 lacs and above.

With above observation, the Board approved the guidelines, to be made effective from 01.01.2020.

With the expansion of Institute activities in the area of academic and research and keeping in view the increased strength of students, a need was felt to create and fill additional positions of Junior Technical Superintendent (05 nos.), Junior Mechanic (02 nos.), cook-cum-caretaker (02 nos.) for the Institute Guest House and International Hostel and Jr. Attendant (02 nos.) for the office of Registrar and other service/administrative units respectively.

Present strength of the non-faculty including posts to be filled up for which advertisement has been published, is 172. The Ministry vide F.No 32-14/2013-T.S1 dated 10th June 2013 has decided to allow IITs to design their administrative / management / technical staff structure as per requirement after due approval from their BoG and to recruit non-faculty positions as per the 10:1.1 student to non-faculty ratio. Strength of Students as on date is 1810 (likely to go up very soon close to 2000) and accordingly the total strength of non-faculty at this point should be within 199 (can be extended very soon).

Phase II construction works of the Institute are being executed by the NCC through CPWD. On 27th November, 2019, an unfortunate incidence of firing happened inside the premises between two contractors of the NCC as a result of which 03 labourers of the NCC were got injured. All the culprits were nabbed by the Bihar Police within no time.

As action points, CCTVs were immediately made operative at both the gates of the institute, hand held scanners were purchased for effective frisking and entry in the register has been made mandatory for all the vehicles entering the campus.

A police outpost was sanctioned by the State Govt. for IIT Patna few years back for which necessary land has been earmarked with the approval of BoG. Pending construction of the permanent building of outpost, an on campus temporary accommodation has been offered to establish the outpost immediately. Police piquet has been deployed at the Institute.

At present security of the campus is being managed by a private agency. As a most suited solution, the institute has now approached the Govt. of Bihar for deployment of Home Guards on payment basis, in place of the existing arrangement.

The Board noted the above. After examining the pros & cons. of various options for campus security, a well-considered scheme may be circulated by email to the Board members for their appraisal.
